MONTREAL MIXES TRENDINESS & TRADITION

Discover Montreal's cultural heritage and cosmopolitan blend of the old and new on this city tour. **Old Montreal, the financial district, Westmount** and its opulent residences, **Montreal's Universities**, and the world renowned **St. Joseph's Oratory**. The tour includes a stop on **Mount Royal** for a panoramic view of Montreal and a visit of **Notre-Dame Basilica**, an outstanding example of neo-gothic architecture. See the **Olympic Park**, the **Botanical Garden** and **Biodôme**. Drive through **St. Helen's** and **Notre-Dame Islands**, sites of Expo '67, the Casino and the Montreal Grand Prix and have a peek at our famous Underground City.

A DAY IN ROMANTIC QUEBEC CITY

Classified as a UNESCO heritage site in 1985, the city of Quebec, capital of the province of Quebec, is the only remaining entirely fortified city in North America. Founded in 1608 by Samuel de Champlain, Quebec was the first permanent European settlement in New France. A natural citadel, the site dominates the St. Lawrence river. Renowned for its European flavour, the city offers a rich architecture. During the tour, you will see the **Ursuline Convent**, the **Plains of Abraham**, the **Parliament** and the famous **Château Frontenac** and the **Montmorency Falls**. Lunch is included in a quaint establishment of Quebec.

MONTREAL COSMOPOLITAN

This unique tour looks at Montreal's cultural and ethnic diversity. After stopping in the **Chinese district**, the tour takes you on **St. Lawrence Boulevard**, the oldest commercial street in Montreal, to see the **Eastern European and Portuguese districts**. A stop is also planned in the **Hassidic Jewish district**. Finally, we go thru the colourful **Little Italy** before coming back to your hotel.
